

## BlackBerry Enterprise Server 4.1 for vodafone Microsoft Exchange

Standard Installation Requirements (v1.2)

Note: Installation Requirements for a standard BES setup (without Mobile Data System) with all components running on a single server, with exception of BlackBerry Configuration Database on SQL Server. If you wish to have more detailed information, install components on a separate server, or install extra components, please consult the BES 4.1 Installation Guide. Consider any impacts on system resources when deciding where to install a component.
